

Community Issues - ASB

Patrolling as a PCSO [Click here to see a sampler](#) This activity aims to highlight the issues relating to anti-social behaviour. Role-playing as PCSOs it encourages children to think about the effects of their behaviour on other people.

Alcohol and Solvents This story centres on Threeboys Convenience Store in Waverly Road. Two 10 year olds buy solvents from the shop and sniff them, two 15 year olds buy vodka from the shop and one collapses through alcoholic poisoning and the shop assistant refuses to sell a caffeine drink because she thinks it is alcoholic. The children will be asked to direct the movements and actions of two police beat officers and a drugs advisor from the local drug agency. The children will be asked to advise the characters in the story as the scenario unfolds.

Consequences of Crime An activity that helps young people explore how attitudes and behaviours can have a wide ranging impact on those involved and others.

Graffiti Taking on the role as members of the management committee of Huntingbridge Community Centre, pupils will look at the problems in the area and some budgetary problems that may need some debate.

The Trouble with Gangs As gangs cause increasing concern pupils will work through a scenario to examine the issues.

Safe on the Street Concern for the well being of young people as they go about their lives within their communities. This lesson looks at the issues of keeping safe and avoiding risks.
