Distraction Burglary [Click here to see a trailer](#) The scenario deals with the safety of the elderly person who is the victim in the story. Children will watch short cartoons and then read some supporting text about what the potential victim could do to avoid problems. Once they have decided on a safe strategy they can confer with an on-line team of experts about what action should be taken. At the end of the scenario all the children in the class will be presented with certificates stating that they have an understanding of what 'Distraction Burglary' is. They will be encouraged to fill these out and present them to their grandparents/older neighbours for them to place on the back of the front door to remind them to be careful when people call.

It has clips in it from 'Not sure, don't open the door' a film made for Derbyshire Constabulary.
